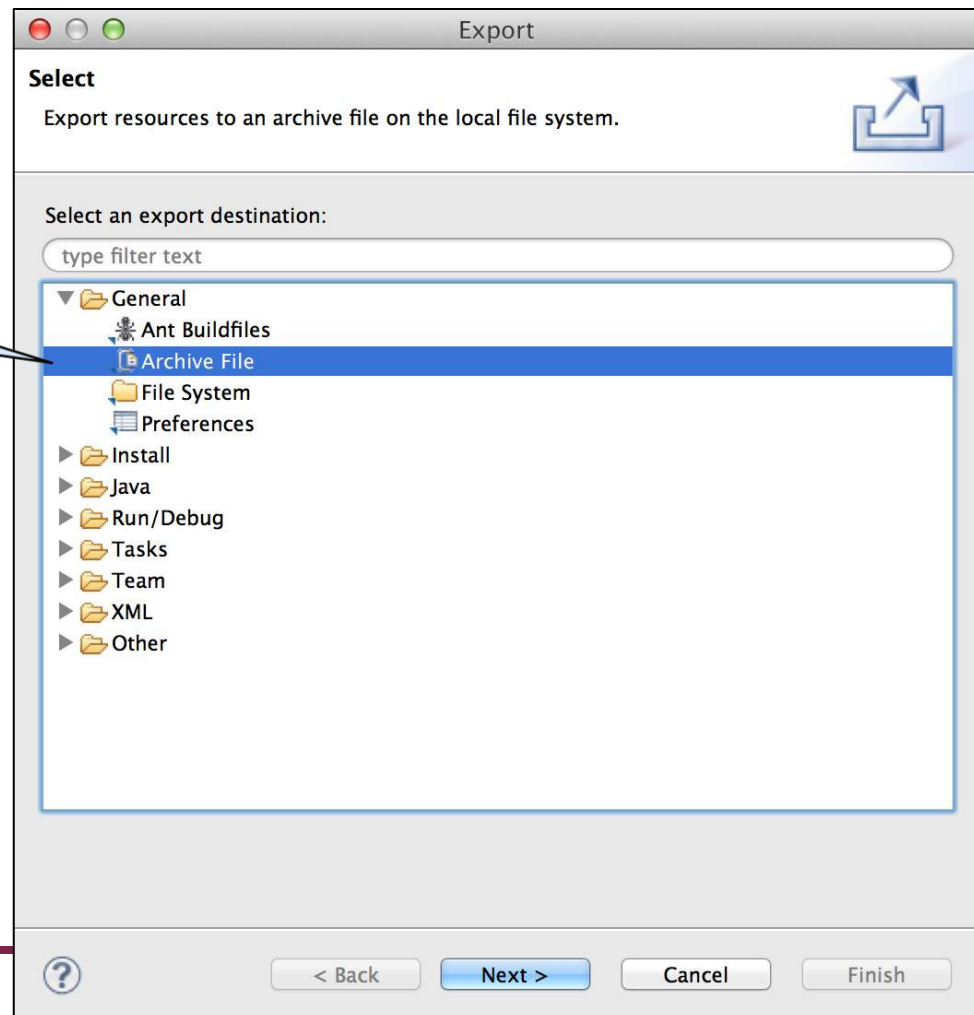

Archiving an Eclipse Project

- First **select the project** that you want to export from the Package Explorer (left-hand side)
- Then: **File -> Export**

Click on the **Archive File** option under **General**.

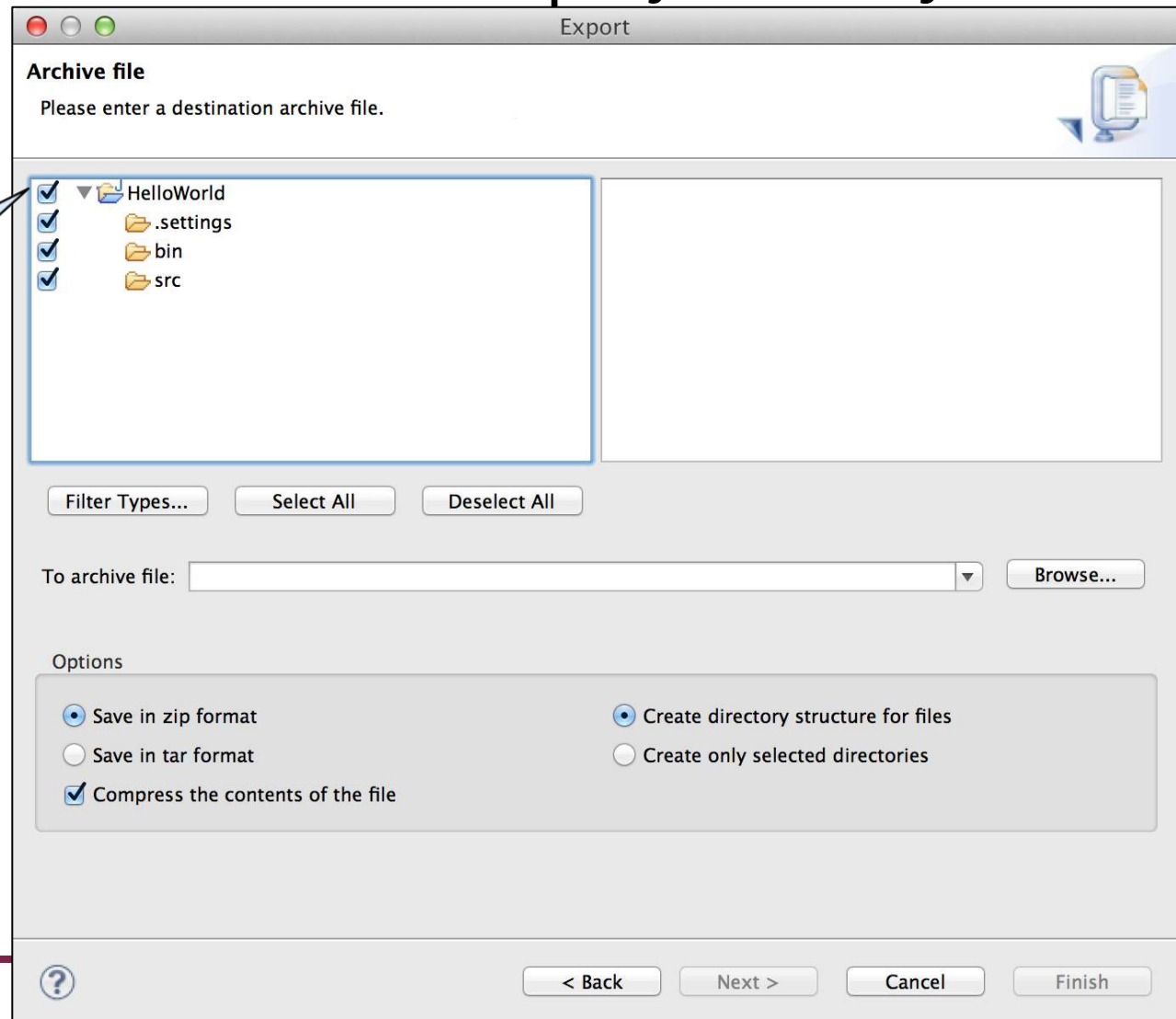
- Then click **Next**



Archiving an Eclipse Project

- Check the box next to the one project that you want to export.

Click on the triangle next to the project to expand the menu (to see all files)

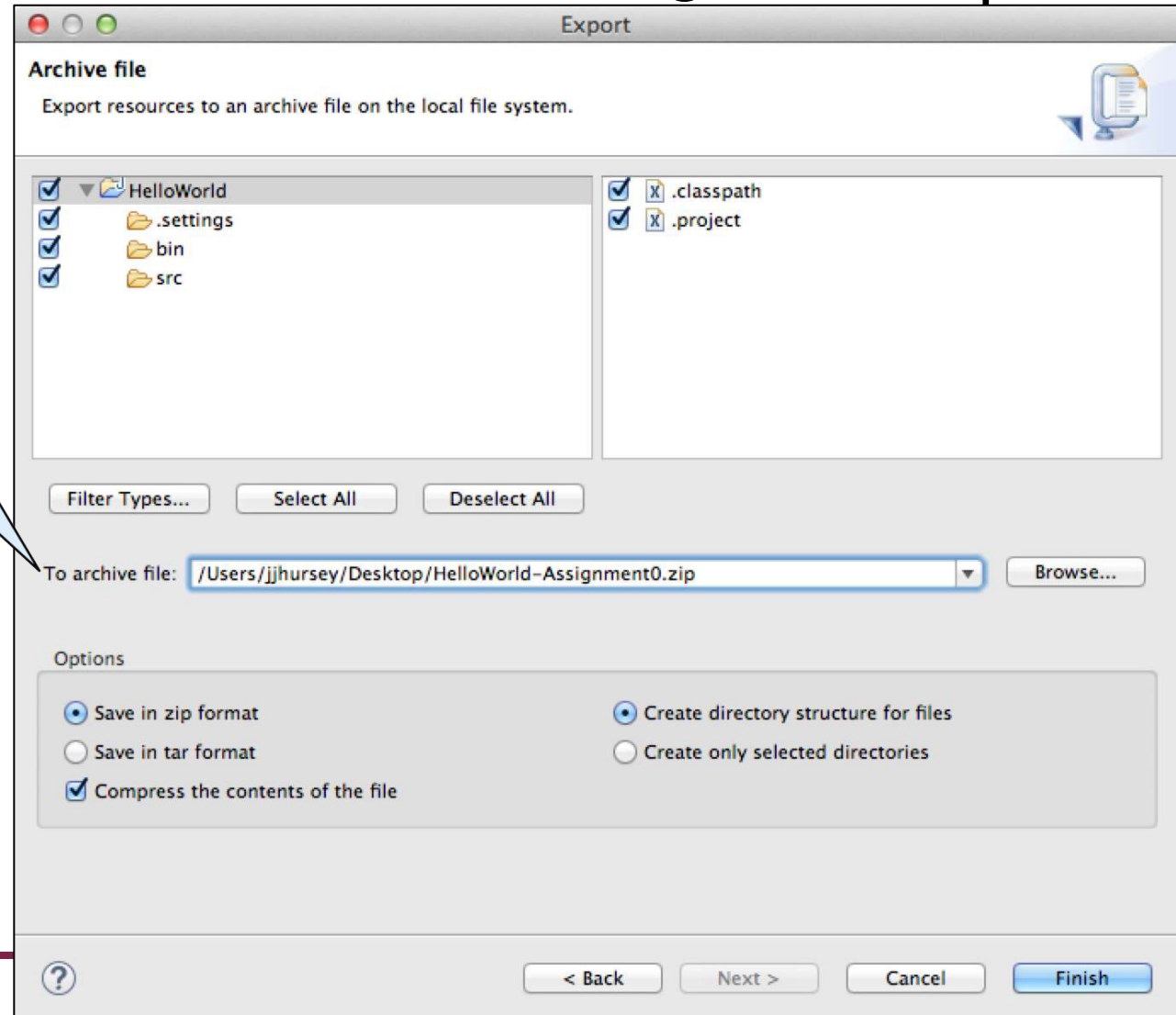


Archiving an Eclipse Project

Click **Browse...** to select a location (e.g., Desktop) and a filename for your archive

The archive file should have the extension **.zip**

Then click on **Finish** to create the file.



Archiving an Eclipse Project

- **Checking the Archived project before submission**
 - Find the **.zip file** in your file system.
 - **Decompress the archive** (usually by double clicking on it).
 - Note: Windows users may need to use the "Extract all" button <http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows-8/zip-unzip-files>
 - Check to make sure that the **src directory contains all of the .java files** that you want to submit.

- **What to submit for an assignment**
 - Submit the **.zip file**
 - If you are using D2L **make sure that the file is completely submitted before logging out.**
 - **Note** that this often requires two different confirmation screens!
